Difficult words

- if there is a word that cannot be read ask the child to try reading on, or read the sentence again. Ask what letter the word starts with and if still unsure, tell the child the word.

Ask

- about the cover and discuss what the book will be about.
- which character was liked the most and ask why.
- what information was found.
- how could the author change the end.
